This eco-friendly process utilizes biodegradable plant-based tannins, such as quebracho, mimosa, and chestnut, making it one of the most environmentally conscious types of leather available today.

What is vegetable-tanned leather?

Vegetable-tanned leather is tanned using natural plant-based tannins, which come from tree bark, leaves, and fruits. This method has been used for centuries and offers a sustainable alternative to traditional chrome-tanning processes, which use harmful chemicals. The use of plant-based tannins not only makes the leather more eco-friendly but also ensures a cleaner and safer production process.

Why we made the change.

Our move to vegetable-tanned leather is not just about reducing our environmental impact; it's about providing our customers with a product that exceeds expectations in terms of quality, comfort, and safety. With its natural beauty, enhanced durability, and sustainability, Veg-tan leather is the perfect fit for the high standards we hold for our products and for the future we want to help create.

Consciously Crafted, Naturally Beautiful

At Albion, we use only the finest materials, selecting first-choice skins with minimal defects to ensure exceptional quality. Our tannery supports ethical and sustainable practices by offering financial assistance to farmers to remove barbed wire fencing and protect livestock from insect bites. We work exclusively with full-grain leather, which is never sanded—preserving the hide's natural strength and character. The vegetable tanning process keeps the leather fibers intact, allowing the material to remain supple and full of life. Finally, we finish our leather with aniline—a non-coating treatment that enables it to breathe and better absorb cleaning products, enhancing both longevity and ease of care.




At Albion, we select only the finest full-grain, first-choice hides — the highest grade from four skin categories — ensuring our saddles are made from leather with minimal imperfections and exceptional natural character.

The use of vegetable-tanning keeps the leather fibers intact and “alive.” This results in enhanced flexibility, strength, and durability, while also making the leather naturally hypoallergenic and resistant to UV damage, helping prevent premature fading.

Our aniline finishing allows the leather to breathe and absorb oils and cleaning products more effectively, promoting longevity and ease of maintenance without the need for synthetic coatings.

All of these qualities come together to create leather that lives and develops a beautiful patina over time.

To suit your individual requirements, you can choose from a carefully curated range of leather finishes — each offering its own unique feel, appearance, and performance characteristics. Whether you prioritise grip, softness, durability or aesthetics, there's a finish to complement your personal preferences.

Buffalo Leather Care Instructions

As with all our leathers, the vegetable-tanning process keeps the material in an ‘alive’ state. This means regular conditioning is essential to maintain the performance and appearance of your saddle over time. Every saddle should be thoroughly balmed before its first use — but Buffalo leather in particular undergoes a striking transformation once treated.

Upon arrival, Buffalo may have a nubuck-like texture. However, once balmed, it develops a deeper, richer tone and a noticeably smoother finish — while significantly enhancing surface grip for a more secure ride.

Before first use, apply a generous layer of Albion Luxury Leather Balm across the entire saddle. Once fully absorbed, a second coat may be necessary to achieve even coverage. Allow the leather to rest for at least 12 hours before riding. Ensure the balm is fully dry before use to avoid transfer onto clothing, avoid wearing light breeches for initial use.

Conditioning frequency depends on; how often you use the saddle, your local climate (e.g., humid environments require less frequent conditioning). **Avoid over-balming.** Applying too much product too often may compromise the integrity of the leather fibres.


Customisations Index

Every part of the Albion Saddle is crafted in our factory in Walsall, West Midlands.

At Albion, we believe that true precision in saddle making comes from considering both the horse and the rider. Our goal is to create a saddle that perfectly fits both. We take a holistic approach to saddle fitting, meaning there isn't a single component we can't adjust to suit the unique needs of each horse and rider pair.

Why we consider the human anatomy when designing the saddle.

The rider's balance centers on the pelvis. Its position affects the rider's seat, leg placement, back function, and how they move with the horse. If the saddle does not support the rider's biomechanics, it disrupts the harmony with the horse, ultimately impacting the horse's movement.




The seat of the saddle is crucial for rider development. We need to ensure the rider is balanced through the seat, with their weight evenly distributed across the panels. Our most recent research explored the rider's pelvic range in depth, demonstrating how a correctly positioned seat, tailored to the rider's pelvic range, allows for free movement in harmony with the horse.

Why the rider's pelvis determines the choice of seat.

The morphology of the pelvis determines the choice of seat in two ways; **seat length** and **seat width**.

The positioning of the seat bones is conditioned by seat size, as indicated in the diagram. The smaller the saddle size, the closer the pelvis is to the pommel.

Therefore the size of the seat directly affects how the pelvis engages, which in turn influences the rider's positioning on the saddle.



CUSTOMISATION OPTIONS FOR THE RIDER

Twist Profile.

With the addition of foam in the twist region, the twist profile can be adjusted in order to support the rider's pelvic range of movement.

Narrow Twist enables the pelvis to engage closer to the pommel and facilitates lateral leg opening.

Wide Twist provides support under the adductor muscle and facilitates leg opening.



Seat Depth.

A rider may request a deeper seat when seeking a more secure feel from the saddle. This is achieved by building up the front of the saddle and placing a deeper cantle onto the saddle.



Block Shape and Position.

Albion blocks are ergonomically designed to provide support to the rider as needed.

Our dressage range features blocks in various sizes and positions, to allow the rider to find the center of balance through their seat. In the jump range, the blocks support riders as their position shifts during takeoff, flight, and landing over fences.

The block positioning has been developed over years of research and data collection, ensuring an "off-the-peg" fit for most riders. For those seeking a more customised fit, Albion offers bespoke block positioning to meet individual needs.

TREES AND TEMPLATING

All Albion Trees are made in our factory in Walsall, West Midlands.

The Adjusta-Tree™ is specifically designed to be adjusted by any local Albion saddle fitter using pressure. This allows fitting modifications, using Albion approved pressure systems, without causing damage or distortion to the tree's headplates or rivets, all while keeping the tree intact within the saddle.

The Adjusta-Tree™ is robustly engineered to withstand weight loading and pressure induced spread. It has been rigorously tested using Albion's own in-house mechanical spread testing equipment and further validated by an independent engineering laboratory with approved heavy load testing systems.

Albion's trees are precisely engineered to be accurate and symmetrical within a tolerance of +/-2mm, in compliance with the British Standard specification BS6635. Each tree undergoes strict quality control and is checked for accuracy and symmetry on a British Standard-approved engineer's inspection table before leaving the workshop.

Albion Precision Templating kit - what it is and why we use it.

Albion templating is essential to our commitment to saddle fitting precision. Not only does it provide us with valuable data for refining our saddle designs, but it's also crucial for ensuring a perfect fit for every horse.


Using the Albion Precision Templating Kit, we create a 2D representation of the horse's back on paper. This template allows us to accurately assess various aspects of the horse's conformation, including its shape, profile, and any areas of weakness. Once the template, along with supporting photos, is sent to our factory, we use it to recreate the horse's back profile on our in-house precision fitting horse.

This templating process is vital for building a custom saddle, ensuring the tree is perfectly tailored to your horse's unique shape and needs.

- The Albion tree warranty is 5 years for breakage while subject to normal usage and conditions
- All adjustments to Albion trees must be carried out by authorised persons and approved equipment only
- Adjusta-Tree™ is suitable for pressure machine adjustment by approved pressure systems
- Adjusta-Tree™ can be altered by 1 fitting up or down
- After two tree adjustments the rivets should be checked
- All other trees (pre 2014) must be returned to the Albion factory for adjustment




Tree Heads.

Three unique shapes of tree head (each adjustable in width) allow for unrivaled adaptation to the horse. Because of this, the horse fitting becomes independent of the rider fitting, ensuring optimum unity in practice.


The **V Tree**, previously known as the TB Tree, has a V-shaped head to adapt to angular horses and offers several arch openings.



The **U Tree**, previously known as the WB Tree, features a U-shaped head designed for wider, more muscular horses. It offers several arch openings and is inspired by the design of the Platinum saddle tree. The U Tree incorporates an innovative feature that moves the bottom of the arch leg back by 1 cm, allowing even greater freedom of movement for the horse's shoulder.



The **XU Tree**, formerly the CC, has an Extra U-shaped head which is more suited for Cob and Connemara breeds. It features shorter points and a flat tree as standard. Curved trees are available upon request.

Flare Point Option:

How to Measure the Tree Head.


The shape of the tree points for dressage are different to jump, therefore have different measurement points.

Dressage / GP Tree

The tree points of a dressage and GP saddle tree are square. The measurement is taken at the rear tip of the leg.

Jump Tree

For jump trees, the tree points are sanded and rounded. The measurement is taken in the middle of the tree points.

Please note: The V-shape Kontinuum Dressage tree has the same measurements as our other dressage trees. The difference is that the tree points are slightly angled—this reflects the original K2 Tree design. therefore, the V-shape Kontinuum Dressage Tree uses its own specific acetate.


The K4 Jump is now available in V, U and XU tree shape. This tree features short tree points, therefore it's important to use the corresponding measurement table and designated acetate.

Fusion Tree Head Measurements.

Due to the Fusion having its own distinct tree shape, a true V or U profile is not achievable. The Fusion tree sits between a traditional V and U shape (see diagram for reference). This tree shape has remained unchanged since the launch of the Fusion.

JUMP TREE HEAD MEASUREMENTS CONTINUED

Kontinuum Tree Head Measurements.

The Kontinuum tree is the same across dressage, jump, and GP models. However, measurements differ between dressage and jump saddles because, as explained on page 10, the reference points used for measurement—specifically those related to the tree point shape—are not taken from the same location.

As a result, compared to other jumping trees, the Kontinuum jump tree has longer tree points (24 mm longer), matching

the length of the dressage tree points. This explains the measurement differences observed between K4, Fusion and Kontinuum.

CUSTOMISATION OPTIONS FOR THE HORSE

Shape of Longitudinal Part of the Tree.

Available in two fitting solutions that follows the shape of the back between the withers and the lumbar region. This allows fitting for all types of conformation.



Curved Tree features shaped rails to allow the tree to follow the contours of the horses back.



Flat Tree is flat all the way through the rails. This allows the midsection of the tree to match the horse's widening profile and not in anyway dig in to them.

Panel Depth Customisation.

The gusset depth is important depending on the conformation of the horse. The rear gusset may need to be increased if there is a larger true drop.

The panel may need to be made thinner or thicker along the tree line. This can be attributed to an under developed topline where atrophy is shown or may need to be slimmer on a wider horse. Both areas are important and subtle changes can be made through flocking.



V & U Tree:

3" Gusset as standard.
2.5" and 3.5" is an option.

XU Tree:

2.5" Gusset as standard with slim front gussets.
3" is an option.

Short Back Panel.

Due to the modern day sport horse becoming shorter through breeding, short back panels are standard for all models. The short back panels eliminate pressure directly behind the saddle, allowing freedom of movement for the horse over the back and loin area and in turn, maximised hock engagement. Panels can also come as standard or can be swept. A swept panel may be required when a horse has a sharp rise through their back from T18.



Panel Width Customisation.

To increase the contact area, the panel width can be altered on all dressage models. This is particularly helpful in a more angular horse or where you may see atrophy. In some cases a drop panel may be required and can be ordered.

CUSTOMISATION OPTIONS FOR THE HORSE

Bolt In Panels.

All saddles will now be made with a bolt in panel. This makes it easier for the fitter when adjusting the tree in the field.

The fitter can drop the panels by unscrewing either the head nail, or the fall down and measure the tree points for accuracy. The panels below the points are secured with Velcro to enable the bolt in system.

This is also helpful when fitting as it is easy to lift the flaps and see the panel bearing surface on the horse.


Choose between 2 or 3 straps:

This option consists of Point and Behind the Point, then a choice of back option, either V-Web or Balance V-Web.

If 2 Straps:

Choose a front option, either Point or Behind the Point. Then select a back option, either V-Web or Balance V-Web.

Girth Strap Options - Jump Mono-flap.

For the Fusion, K4 and Kontinuum Jump: Behind point, then either the V-Web or Balance V-Web.

Special Requests: For the Kontinuum, it is possible to request a point strap, like the dressage tree.





Girth Strap References

Point Strap:

The point strap can be used to secure the saddle if the saddle slips forward and may be used if girthing asymmetrically. This should not be used when girthing neutrally.

Neutral Girthing:

Neutral girthing uses the 'behind the point' and V Web.

Balance V-Web:

The balance V-Web can be added to any of the models as an option. This must be requested at the point of ordering the saddle.



UNITY DRESSAGE

A series of saddles developed to enhance the rider's pelvic motion, resulting in the rider becoming more in sync with the horse's movement. A saddle uniting horse and rider.

The Unity Series is available in X and Y seat profiles plus V, U and XU trees for the ultimate in saddle fitting precision.

For the rider, there are two different seats correlating to two different morphologies.

X seat: wide twist, which opens up the rider's leg and sits them back slightly. It encourages the anterolateral opening of the leg by moving the pelvis backwards.

Y seat: narrow twist, allowing the rider to be more on top of their feet. Narrower seat, more suitable for a smaller pelvis like a man's, allowing the leg to be opened laterally.


